Florida Whig Party Delegate

FWP Delegates have one vote on matters presented to Delegates by the Executive Committee, are invited to the annual convention, and will receive a FWP lapel pin, bumper sticker, and membership card.

The Webster Committee

Named in honor of Secretary of State (and United States Senator) Daniel Webster, who was one of the famous orators of the Early American Whig Party. Webster Committee members are FWP Delegates and receive priority Webinar reservations, conference seating, and assignments.

The General Scott Brigade

Named in honor of the 1852 Whig Party Presidential Candidate, Winfield Scott (Old Fuss & Feathers) who served on active duty as general longer than any other man in American history; 55 years. Scott served as the Commander General of the United States Army for 20 years; longer than anyone before or since. General Scott is also famous for the Anaconda Plan; the plan used by Union to defeat the Confederacy during the Civil War. In addition to Delegate and Webster benefits, Scott's Brigade will receive a unique lapel pin and a private meeting with the Executive Board during the annual convention.

The Clay Council

Named in honor of the Founding Father of the Whig Party, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Secretary of State, Henry Clay, Sr. Known as "The Great Compromiser", Clay was named one of the five greatest senators in U.S. History by a Senate committee chaired by John F. Kennedy. Clay Council members receive all Delegate, Webster, and Scott benefits, in addition to an annual dinner with the Executive Board, a unique lapel pin, plaque, and special recognition at all meetings.
